

## **Louise Robert**

**Nov. 16, 1905 - June 21, 1984**

Mrs. Ernest (Louise) Robert, 78, Monticello. died unexpectedly on Thursday, June 21, 1984 in Pleasant View Nursing Home, Monroe, where she had been admitted the previous day. Death resulted from an embolism.

The former Louise Stauffer was born in Monticello on Nov. 16, 1905, the daughter of Robert and Rose Elmer Stauffer. She attended Silver Rural School. On May 29, 1930, she was married to Ernest J. Robert, in the Zwingli Church parsonage in Monticello, with the late Rev. Albert Muehlmeier officiating. The couple farmed in Mt. Pleasant Township until retiring and moving to the village of Monticello.

She was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, and the Attica Homemakers Club, where she was a 25-year member.

Funeral services were held Monday, June 25, in the Zwingli United Church of Christ with the Rev. Charles G. Workman officiating. Burial was in the Highland Cemetery, Monticello.

Survivors are her husband, Ernest: one daughter, Mrs. James (Rosemary) Olmstead, Plattsburg, N.Y.; one son, Donald E. Robert, rural Albany; one brother, Wilbert E. Stauffer, Monticello; three sisters, Mrs. Alma Brecklin, Monroe; Mrs. Harvey (Hilda) Milbrandt, Monticello, and Mrs. Helen Stauffer, Madison, and seven grandchildren.

Preceding her in death were her mother in 1929, father in 1950 and a brother, Herman, in 1938.
