Fred S. Roethlisberger, 86, a former Monticello resident died Tuesday, Sept. 18, 1984, at Pleasant View Nursing Home, Monroe.

He was born in Warren, Ill., Jan. 28, 1898, the son of Simon and Elise Mueller Roethlisberger. He attended Wavne Township rural schools in Lafayette County, and also attended a mechanics school in Milwaukee. He was married Dec. 29, 1924, in Milwaukee, to Barbara Duerst. They had been residents of Monticello since 1926.

He operated a gas and service station and then later he operated a refrigeration service until his retirement. He was a resident of Pleasant View since 1976.
