Mrs. Stella Rowan, 81, Dies; Services Held Here Saturday

Funeral services for Mrs. Stella R. Rowan, 81, years of age, Cincinnati, Ohio, who died on Wednesday, Dec. 26, at the home of her daughter, Mrs. R. W. Karlen, Sr., Monticello, were held at 1 Saturday afternoon at the Voegeli funeral home here.

The Rev. J. Allan Mittler, pastor of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, officiated, and burial was in Highland cemetery here. Pallbearers were Alfred Isely, Henry Duerst, C. W. Karlen, Fred A. Karlen, Royal W. Karlen, Jr., and Thomas Runkle, Sr.

Mrs. Rowan had been ill for nine months, suffering from a malignancy. She had been hospitalized for five months in Cincinnati and was brought here by air ambulance in September.

Stella Mae Sutter was born in Newtonsville, Ohio, June 25, 1881, the daughter of Jacob and Charlena Moore Sutter. She took nurses training in Cincinnati, and on June 21, 1905, was united in marriage in Cincinnati to Robert C. Rowan, They always lived there, where she was engaged as a nurse,

Mrs. Rowan was a member of the Walnut Hill-Avandale Methodist church, Cincinnati, and was very active in church organizations as long as her health permitted.

She is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Karlen, Monticello, and Mrs. Dorothy M, Grey, Portland, Ore.; two brothers, two sisters, 10 grandchildren, and two great-grandchildren,

She was preceded in death by her husband, one son, one daughter, and one grandson.
