

**Viola M. Rupp**  
**Oct. 18, 1904 - November 29, 1967**  
**Miss Rupp, 63, Monticello, Dies**

Miss Viola M. Rupp, 63, Monticello, ill but a short time, died at 6:45 this morning, Nov. 29, in St. Clare Hospital, where she had been employed. Miss Rupp was hospitalized as a medical patient in mid - afternoon yesterday.

Prior to working at the hospital, in the laundry department, she had clerked at Rottler's Store in Monroe, and for many years clerked at Peoples' Supply Co. store in Monticello.

Viola Marie Rupp was born in Monticello Oct. 18, 1904, a daughter of Jacob and Ann Speich Rupp. She attended Simmons rural school, when the family farmed south of Monticello, and also Monticello schools.

She was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ of Monticello.

The only immediate survivors are a nephew, Frederick Rupp, Monticello, and five nieces, Misses Betty and Kathryn Rupp, both of Elgin, Ill.; Mrs. Jack Miller, Plymouth; Mrs. David Holman, Janesville, and Mrs. Nathan Klassy, Monroe.

She was preceded in death by her father, April 21, 1963; her mother, April 16, 1950, and two brothers, Jacob Rupp Jr., Monroe, June 1, 1958, and Herman, Nov. 14, 1909.

Funeral services will be at 1:30 p.m. Friday, Dec. 1, in Zwingli Church of Monticello. Her pastor, Rev. J. Allen Mittler, is to officiate. Burial will be in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
