February 11, 1907 - November 20, 1994

MONTICELLO — Anna Saxer, age 87, resident of the New Glarus Home, passed away on Sunday evening, November 20, 1994, at the Monroe Clinic Hospital.

She was born in Washington Township, Green County, Wisconsin, on February 11, 1907, the former Anna Gerber, daughter of Ulrich and Emma (Friehtor) Gerber. She married John Saxer on November 27, 1924, in Monticello, and he preceded her in death March 25, 1981. She attended Marty School in Washington Township and following her marriage, Anna and her husband farmed in Mount Pleasant and Exeter Townships, moving to Monroe in 1957. Anna worked as a nurses aide at Pleasant View Nursing Home until her retirement in 1972. She was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, and the New Glarus Alpine and Senior Citizen Clubs.

She is survived by three sons, Werner “John” and Edwin, both of Monticello, and Harry of New Glarus; a brother, Werner Gerber of Argyle; 29 grandchildren; 59 great-grandchildren; and 16 great-great-grandchildren. In addition to her husband, she was preceded in death by two daughters, Hilda Wirth and Wilma Fosaaen; a brother, Otto; a sister, Martha Hess; two grandsons; one great-granddaughter; and one great-grandson.

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, November 23, 1994, at 1:30 p.m. at the ZWINGLI UNITED CHURCH OF CHRIST in Monticello, with the Reverend Erwin H. Pegel officiating.
