Mrs. Schlittler, Monticello, Dies

MONTICELLO — Mrs. Edward Schlittler, 71, died at 7 a.m. yesterday at her home here after a long illness. She was hospitalized two weeks, returning to her home on Dec. 31.

Mrs. Schlittler was the former Susanna Elmer, daughter of Henry and Anna Rhyner Elmer. She was born Dec. 9, 1887, on the Elmer homestead farm, southeast edge of the village. On Jan. 30, 1918, she was married at Monticello to Edward Schlittler. They farmed in Washington Township area for 33 years, retiring to the village in 1957. They observed their golden wedding anniversary in January 1958.

She was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ and a former member of its Aid society.

Surviving are the husband; two sons, Herman and Carl; a daughter, Mrs. Edward J. (Hilda) Marty, all of Monticello, and six grandchildren. She was preceded in death by a daughter, Barbara, in infancy; a son, Walter in 1956; a brother, John C. Elmer in 1953 and a sister, Mrs. Anton Hefty in 1958.

Services will be at 2 p.m. Wednesday in the Zwingli church, with Rev. A. R. Achtemeier, pastor, officiating. Burial will be in Highland cemetery. Friends may call at the Voegeli funeral home after 1 p.m. tomorrow.
