MADISON/MONTICELLO — Mrs. Lona E. Schuler, age 81, widow of Adam A. Schuler, formerly of 601 N. Midvale Boulevard, Madison, passed away on Wednesday, August 2 at a Moorhead, Minnesota Care Facility.

She was born in Green County, Wisconsin on August 9, 1907, the daughter of C. Fred and Ellen (Streiff) Disch.
