LeRoy A. Schultz, 57, 2520 16th Ave., died on Friday, April at his home.

He was born on November 23, 1923 in Freeport, the son of Roy and Marie Mabel (Stauffacher) Schultz. A 1941 Monroe High School graduate, he also graduated from the UW-Madison School of Engineering.

On November 17, 1944, he married Inez Schuler in Monticello. He worked in the engineering department at Kimberly-Clark in Neenah, Niagara and Kimberly, Wis. for 17 years before returning to Monroe in 1968 where he owned and operated Schultz Motorcycle and Gun Shop.

He is survived by his widow, Inez, two sons: Jerry, Racine, and John, Oshkosh; a daughter, Judy, Janesville and two grandsons.

He was preceded in death by his father in 1964 and his mother in 1973.
