Services Held Here For Mrs. Schultz, 75

Funeral services for Mrs. Isaac Schultz, 75 years of age, Madison, a one-time Monticello resident, who died at 1 a.m. last Thursday in the Methodist hospital, Madison, after a long illness, were held at 2 Monday afternoon in the Memorial Lounge at Zwingli United Church of Christ here. The Rev. J. Allan Mittler, church pastor, officiated, and interment was in Highland cemetery.

Mrs. Schultz had recently resided in a Madison nursing home. She had suffered a stroke March 18, 1955, and for many years had resided at the Green County hospital and since last fall in the Madison nursing home.

Louise Rose Marty was born in New Glarus, April 17, 1893, a daughter of Fred and Mary Duerst Marty. She was married on Thanksgiving day in 1913, at New Glarus, to Isaac Schultz. They lived in Monticello until 1925, during which time Mr. Schultz was employed at the Karlen & Steinmann Lumber company. Leaving here, they resided in New Glarus for four years and in September, 1929, moved to Madison.

Mrs. Schultz was a member of the Ladies Auxiliary of the Carpenters Union, 314, Madison.

She is survived by her husband; three sons, Robert, Vernon, and Adrian, all of Madison, and five grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by one brother and one sister.
