

Marion P. “Mutch” Schulz

Oct. 8, 1922 - Aug. 5, 1985

Marion P. “Mutch” Schulz, 62, Monroe, died Monday, Aug. 5, 1985, at his home in Monroe.

He was born Oct. 8, 1922, the son of Lester E. and Mabel Clarno Schulz. He was a 1941 graduate of Monticello High School.

A World War II veteran, he entered the Army on June 20, 1944, at Ft. Sheridan, Ill., and was discharged on March 20, 1945, and held the rank of private, serving with Headquarters Detachment 1219th SCSU. He had been employed at lumber companies in Monroe.

He was a member of the Amstutz-Marty American Legion Post of Monticello.

Funeral services were held Thursday, Aug. 8, at the Stuessy Funeral home, Monroe. Burial was in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.

Survivors include three brothers, Harold Schulz, Brodhead, Lester, Durand, and Paul, Monroe; four sisters, Mrs. Ruth Stauffer, Waunakee, Mrs. George (Kathryn) Grenzow, Monticello, Mrs. Nathan (Elaine) Mauermann, Monroe, and Mrs. Ralph (Doris) Ziltner, New Glarus.

Preceding him in death were his father in 1954, his mother in 1979, and two brothers in infancy.
