

**Lawrence Schwartz**  
**Feb. 26, 1904 - Jan. 27, 1974**

Lawrence H. Schwartz, 69, died about 2 a.m. Sunday, Jan. 27, in his home at Monticello. He had been ill but a few days. Pneumonia was the cause of death.

Mr. Schwartz had worked at Baker Mfg. Co. in Evansville for 36 years, retiring in 1953 and then moving from Evansville to Monticello. He had owned and operated a Monticello tavern and for the past 12 years had worked at Disch Outlet Store.

He was born Feb. 26, 1904, in Sylvester Township, a son of Fred and Phemina (Famie) Anlauf Schwartz. He attended Searles rural school. On Feb. 14, 1925, he was married in Evansville to Marguerite L. Hansen.

Surviving are his widow, Marguerite, and two brothers, Earle, Milton Junction, and Raymond, Montello.

He was preceded in death by a sister, Mrs. Jacob (Louise) Thompson, Brooklyn; his father, Oct. 10, 1966, and his mother, Jan. 23, 1971.

Services for Mr. Schwartz will be at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday, Jan. 29, in Memorial Lounge of Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello. Rev. Charles G. Workman is to officiate. Burial will be in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
