Mrs. Traugott Senn, 65, Dies Thursday After Long Illness

Critically ill for several weeks as a patient in the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, Mrs. Traugott Senn, 65 years of age, highly esteemed Monticello resident, passed at 3:30 Thursday afternoon.

Mrs. Senn had been in failing health for several months.

Funeral services were held at 2 Saturday afternoon at the Voegeli funeral home, the Rev. A. R. Achtemeier, pastor of the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church, officiated, and burial was in Highland cemetery.

Pallbearers were Henry J. Elmer, Jacob Krieg, C. M. Stauffer, Ernest Schuerch, Louis Wyss and Ted Zurbuchen.

Native of Switzerland

Emma Gubler was a native of Switzerland, having been born Feb. 11, 1889, in Flums, Canton of St. Galen, the daughter of Gottfried and Emma Schaerzinger Gubler. She attended schools in Switzerland and was united in marriage there to Traugott Senn on April 2, 1910. She came to America in 1914. She had made her home in Monticello ever since coming to the United States.

Mrs. Senn was a quiet individual who found pleasure and happiness within the bounds of her own home. News of her passing was received with deep and sincere regret by her many friends and acquaintances.

Surviving are her husband; four brothers and three sisters in Switzerland. She was preceded in death by an only son, Traueott, Jr., in 1937.
