Carl Sieber Dies From Heart Attack

Carl Sieber, 66, City hotel, died yesterday afternoon at 2 in the John Kempfer home, Yellowstone Township, where he was spending the day. He suffered a heart attack.

Mr. Sieber was born Jan. 13, 1880, in Canton Bern, Switzerland. He came to Monroe from Switzerland in 1910 with his mother and three brothers. He farmed near Blue Mounds and in Sylvester Township and was employed for some time by the Ordnance plant at Savanna. For five years, Mr. Sieber was employed by the Huber Brewing Co. here and also worked as custodian in the White Building.

His only immediate survivor is a sister, Mrs. Bertha Bergen, in Switzerland. Mr. Sieber was preceded in death by three brothers, John, Fred and Albert.

Services will be tomorrow at 2 p. m. in the Shriner-Neushwander funeral home. Rev. A. R. Achtemeier, pastor of Zwingli church, Monticello, will officiate. Burial will be in Highland cemetery, Monticello. Friends may call at the funeral home tonight.
