Final Rites Held for Mrs. T. O. Silver
Former Mt. Pleasant Lady Expires Six' Weeks After Mate

Following her late husband in death by only six weeks, Mrs. Truman O. Silver, past 80 years, Albany, former Mt. Pleasant township resident and a citizen of Green county since early childhood, passed away at 4:15 a. m. Saturday, Jan. 16, in the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, where she had been a patient since Nov. 4, when she fell at her home and sustained the fracture of a hip.

Helen Strunk was born in Rensselaer county, N. Y., the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Philip Strunk. She came to Green county when a baby, the family settling in the Farmers' Grove community, near Monticello. She was united in marriage to Truman O. Silver Feb. 3, 1877, and the couple lived on a farm about three miles east of Monticello until two years ago, when they moved to Albany to reside.

Surviving are four children, Mrs. Mable Webster, at home, Mrs. Ben Bly, Evansville, and Ray and Emery Silver, Mt. Pleasant township. There are seven grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

Funeral services were held at 2 on Tuesday afternoon of last week at the Sharer funeral home, Albany, the Rev. Richard C. Werner, pastor of the Baptist church, officiating. Burial was in the Exeter cemetery.
