

Fred Spring

March 26, 1864 - Dec. 30, 1914

Last Wednesday morning, Fred. Spring, a farmer living three miles east of Monticello died suddenly from heart failure. He was just getting up when he was stricken and died a few minutes afterward.

The deceased was born at Wimmis, Kanton Bern, Switzerland 50 years ago and came to this country as a youth and here followed the cheesemaker's vocation for many years. He made a trip to the old country where he was married and then returned to this country again. Several years ago he purchased a farm 3 miles east of Monticello at which place he has since lived.

He is survived by his widow Louise, one daughter, Mrs. Albert Wittwer Jr. of New Glarus and three sons.
