

## **Genevieve Spring**

Mrs. Henry (Genevieve) Spring, 77, Monroe, died Saturday, Jan. 2, 1982, at St. Clare Hospital, Monroe. She had entered the hospital on Dec. 31. She had been in failing health for the past six months.

She was born on April 19, 1904, the daughter of Arthur and Genevieve Elmer Crouch in Washington Township. On Jan. 20, 1927, she was married to Carl Miller who died May 10, 1977. She married Henry Spring on Oct. 1, 1978.

A graduate of Monticello High School and Green County Normal School she had taught country school for two years and farmed with her husband in Mt. Pleasant and Clarno Townships from 1929 to 1955, when they moved to Monroe. After her marriage in 1978, the Springs made their home in Monticello. The couple then moved to Monroe in 1980.

She was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, of the Zwingli Women's Missionary Society, the Richland Homemakers Club, the Royal Neighbors and the G.U.G.G.

Survivors include her husband; one daughter, Mrs. Eugene (Genevieve) Boss, Monroe; two grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

Preceding her in death was a daughter, Marlea Miller, on March 15, 1940 and a brother, Nathan.

Funeral services were held Tuesday, Jan. 5 at the Newcomer Funeral Home, Monroe, with the Rev. Charles G. Workman, officiating.

Burial was in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
