**Mrs. Louise Staedtler, Former Resident of Monticello, Succumbs**

Mrs. Louisa Staedtler, aged 90, 33 Lathrop Street, Madison, passed away Tuesday morning at the Four Winds Manor, Verona, where she had been a patient for several months.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 p. m. Thursday at the Frautschi West funeral home. The Rev. William A. Schultz, of the Memorial Evangelical and Reformed church, Madison, of which she was a member, will officiate.

Burial will be in Highland cemetery, Monticello, at about 2: 45 p. m.

Mrs. Staedtler, the former Louisa Dick, was born in Washington township and was married to Henry Staedtler. Mr. Staedtler owned and operated a feed mill in Monticello before the couple moved to Madison. He passed away in 1927 in Madison. Mrs. Staedtler was also preceded in death by a son, Arnold, who died last winter, by three sisters, Mrs. Rose Wittwer in 1926, Mrs. Mary Wittwer and Mrs. Ella Wittwer, and by three brothers, John, Jacob and Robert Dick.

Survivors include one daughter, Monica Staedtler, and one son, Paul Staedtler, both of Madison, and two sisters, Mrs. Minnie Marty, Los Angeles, Calif., and Mrs. Anna Klossner, Madison.
