

Henry Stauffacher
Oct. 20, 1899 - Nov. 16, 1973

A lifelong Green County resident, Henry Stauffacher, 74, Rt. 1, Monticello, retired Mt. Pleasant Township farmer, died at 1:30 p.m. Friday, Nov. 16, 1973 in St. Clare Hospital. He had been hospitalized in August and re-entered on Oct. 22.

He was born in Monroe, Oct. 20, 1899, a son of Henry and Susanna Kappler Stauffacher. He attended Monroe schools and was confirmed in St. John's United Church of Christ. On Feb. 7, 1922, he was married in New Glarus to Barbara Steiner.

Surviving are a son, Kenneth H., on the home farm; two daughters, Mrs. Royal R. (Helen) Hawkins, Monticello, and Mrs. Orville I. (Doris) Gilbertson, Rt. 1, Monticello; a brother, Carl, Beloit, and six grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Aug. 5, 1962; his mother in 1954; his father, 1941; a brother, Larry, Granton, 1957, and two sisters, Mrs. Christ (Bertha) Schmid, Monticello, 1959, and Mrs. Roy J. (Agnes) Marty, St. Paul, Minn., 1964.

Funeral services for Mr. Stauffacher will be at 1:30 p.m. Monday, Nov. 19, in Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, where he was a member. Rev. Charles G. Workman is to officiate. Burial will be in the family lot at Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
