MADISON/MONTICELLO — Miss Helen V. Stauffer, age 82, a Monticello native, and former resident of the Kennedy Manor, Langdon Street, Madison, passed away on Wednesday, April 20, 1994 at the New Glarus Home where she has been a resident since November 1990.
