Mrs. Jacob Stauffer, 81, Monticello, died Thursday, July 31, in St. Clare Hospital after a short illness. Her funeral was held Sunday, August 3, in Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, where she was a member. Burial was in the Highland Cemetery. Rev. Charles G. Workman officiated.

She was born in rural Barneveld on February 23, 1894, a daughter of John and Julia Urben Ingold. The former Johanna Ingold was married in Monroe to Jacob Stauffer on February 12, 1918. They farmed in Mt. Pleasant Township, until retiring to Monticello in 1949.
