**Nov. 12, 1903 - July 22, 1969**

**Wm. Sullivan, Area Native. Succumbs**

William V. Sullivan, 65, Washington township farmer, died unexpectedly from pneumonia at 7:15 p.m. on Tuesday of last week in the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, where he had been a patient since the previous Friday.

Funeral services were held at 9:30 a. m. Friday at the Stuessy funeral home and in St. Victor's Catholic church, Monroe. The Rev. Lawrence Kieffer officiated, and burial was in Calvary cemetery, Monroe.

Born in Adams township, Nov. 12, 1903, he was a son of John and Catherine Knight Sullivan. He attended rural school near his home and on July 15, 1937, he was united in marriage in Argyle to Helen McGuire. They had since farmed in Washington township.

Mr. Sullivan was a member of St. Victor's Catholic church, Monroe, and a former member of Holy Name Society.

He is survived by his widow; three sons, James, Cross Plains, John, Des Moines, Iowa, and Richard, at home; a daughter, Mrs. Ray Wiegand, Seymour; two brothers, Raymond and Lloyd, Janesville; a sister, Mrs. Michael McGuire, Route 3, Monroe; and a grandson, Timothy Sullivan, Cross Plains.
