Burial Service Held Here for Mrs. Taft

Services Held Friday for Resident of Monticello Many Years

Funeral services for Mrs. Rosa Taft, 81 years of age, former Monticello resident for many years, who passed away on Monday of last week at her home in Whitewater, were held at 1 Friday afternoon in the Skindrude-Lien funeral home, Whitewater, the Rev. Alfred Howe, pastor of the Methodist church, officiating.

Brief burial services were held in Highland cemetery, Monticello, where Mrs. Taft's remains were interred.

Mrs. Taft, who had resided in Whitewater for approximately 20 years, succumbed to old age complications.

The former Rosa Marty, she was born in New Glarus Nov. 17, 1865. On Sept. 15, 1889, she was united in marriage to Frank Taft. They resided in Monticello for many years. Leaving Monticello more than 20 years ago, they moved to the vicinity of Beloit, where they resided for a short time, subsequently moving to Whitewater. Mr. Taft conducted a hardware store there in company with his son, Herbert Taft, for quite a number of years.

Survivors are one son, Herbert F. Taft, Whitewater; a daughter, Mrs. Henry C. Klassy, Monticello; three grandchildren, and four great-grandchildren.
