Emil Theiler, Area Native, Dies Sunday

Emil Albert Theiler, 78, died Sunday at 10:30 a.m. in St. Clare hospital following several strokes.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, Feb. 24, at 1:30 p.m. in the Shriner-Neushwander Funeral Home with Rev. Robert Brightman of the Union Presbyterian church, Monroe, officiating. Burial was in Greenwood cemetery.

Mr. Theiler was born March 18, 1892, in Washington township, the son of David and Sophie Ritschard Theiler. He married Estella Mae Keister on Nov. 16, 1914, the ceremony taking place in Monticello. He farmed for a time and later lived in Monroe.

He was confirmed in Washington Reformation church.

Surviving are his wife; a son, Roland R., Minneapolis, Minn.; a daughter, Mrs. Luther Baumgartner, Darwin, Australia; three brothers, Edwin, Juda, Fred, Browntown, and Ted, Milton; three sisters, Mrs. Bertha Zum Brunnen, Monticello, Minn., Mrs. Mollie Thomas and Mrs. Julie Sullivan, both of Monroe, and three grandchildren.
