JACOB THEILER IS DEAD

WAS AN AGED AND RESPECTED MAN OF OF THIS COUNTY.

Jacob Theiler of Washington township passed away Friday afternoon at the age of 81 years after an illness of about three weeks with pneumonia.

The deceased is an uncle of Robert and Huldah Theiler of this city and grandfather of Mrs. Arnold Daitweiler of this city. John Theiler, editor of the New Glarus paper is a son and two other sons and one daughter survive him: Christ and Gottfried of Washington township, with whom the deceased made his home, and Marie Deuertchi who lives in Switzerland.

The deceased was a native of Switzerland and came direct to Green county from there about twenty years ago. He settled on a farm in Washington township and has resided there ever since.

He contracted a cold some four weeks ago and for three weeks battled with a run of pneumonia and while a man in good health prior to his sickness, his age was against his recovery. He was a man highly respected and esteemed by all who knew him.

The funeral will be held Sunday at 1 o'clock at the home and at 2 o'clock at the German Reformed Church in Washington township.
