Mrs. LeRoy Trumpy Dies Suddenly at 19 Years; Rites Held Sudden Heart Attack is Fatal to Adams Twp. Resident Saturday

Striking suddenly and without warning, death claimed Mrs. LeRoy Trumpy, 19 years of age, at 9:30 Saturday night at her farm home in Adams township, nine miles west of Monticello.

Her sudden and unexpected death was caused by heart failure.

Ellen Mae Sonstebly was born in Dane county, Nov. 15, 1931, the daughter of Adolph and Lillian Anderson Sonstebly. She attended the Spring Valley rural school, northeast of New Glarus. On Jan. 19, 1949, she was united in marriage to LeRoy F. Trumpy, the ceremony taking place in Daleyville. Since their marriage the couple resided on the Jacob Trumpy farm, nine miles west of Monticello.

Surviving are her husband; an infant son, Gordon Duane, born Aug. 14, this year; her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Adolph Sonstebly, Verona; one brother, Jerome, three sisters, Alice, at home, Mrs. Leon Young Belleville, and Mrs. Ernest Rufener, Orangeville, Ill.

Mrs. Trumpy was confirmed in the Primrose Lutheran church Nov. 11, 1945.
