

Rosa Barbara Trumpy
July 23, 1899 - March 3, 1974

Mrs. Jacob J. Trumpy, 74, Rt. 1, Albany, died Sunday noon, March 3, in the New Glarus Home, New Glarus. She had been in failing health several years and had been at the New Glarus Home since October 1971. Prior to that she was at Pleasant View Nursing Home, rural Monroe, since 1968.

The former Rosa Barbara Zentner was born in Corwith, Iowa, July 23, 1899, a daughter of Fridolin and Barbara Legler Zentner. The family moved to the Monticello area in 1911 and she completed her education in the Monticello schools.

She was married May 22, 1917, in Monticello to Jacob J. Trumpy. They farmed in Adams Township for 28 years and then in 1945 purchased the present Trumpy farm in Mt. Pleasant Township, once the Zentner home place.

Mrs. Trumpy was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, and a former member of the East Mt. Pleasant Homemakers.

Surviving are her husband, Jacob; nine children; five daughters, Mrs. Ralph (Helen) Freitag, Rt. 2, Monticello; Mrs. Oliver (Florence) Welton, Monticello; Mrs. Lawrence H. (Marian) Karlen, Rt. 1, Monticello; Mrs. Delbert (Rosemarie) Krupke, Monroe, and Mrs. Merlin (Lorna) Boley, rural Blanchardville; four sons, Floyd, Rt. 1, Albany, on the home place; LeRoy, Orangeville, Ill.; Ray, rural Brooklyn, and Richard, Rt. 2, Monroe; 47 grandchildren, and 27 great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by a daughter, Bertha, Feb. 28, 1926; two sons, Glenn, Aug. 1, 1963, and Norman F., Sept. 6, 1969; two grandchildren, in infancy; three brothers, Fred Zentner, 1918; John 1958, and Alva, 1968, and a brother and a sister in infancy.

Funeral services for Mrs. Trumpy will be at 1:30 pm. Wednesday, March 6, in Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello. Her pastor, Rev. Charles G. Workman, is to officiate. Burial will be there in Highland Cemetery.
