Louis Ubert Age 60, New Glarus, Dies

Louis Ubert, 60 years of age, former Monticello and New Glarus businessman, died at 2:50 a.m. Wednesday in the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, where he had been a patient since Nov. 19.

Born in Monroe, Dec. 20, 1909, he was a son of Christ and Eliza Gerber Ubert. The family lived in Monticello for a number of years, where the deceased operated a service station for some time before moving to New Glarus, where he owned and operated Ubert's D-X station until two years ago.

On Oct. 9, 1940, he was married in Dubuque, Iowa, to Viola Werndli. He was a veteran of World War II, serving in the Army 25 months.

He was a member of the Swiss United Church of Christ, New Glarus, the New Glarus Masonic lodge, Stuessy-Kuenzi American Legion post, and the New Glarus Fire department.

Surviving are his widow and a sister, Mrs. Harold (Clara) Beck, Sun Prairie.

His parents and a brother, Jacob, are deceased.
