

**Alice Van Houten**  
**Feb. 2, 1886 - November 12, 1959**  
**Mrs. Van Houten, Monticello, Dies**

Mrs. John Van Houten, 73, Monticello, died at 3:10 a.m. today in St. Clare hospital where she had been a patient since Tuesday night. She has been ill. since March and hospitalized several times during that period.

A native of Garyp Friesland, Netherlands, Mrs. Van Houten was the former Alice Van ber Veen. She was born Feb. 2, 1886, the daughter of Gurgun and Anka Bes Van ber Veen.

On July 7, 1909, she married John Van Houten in the Netherlands and they came here in 1911. They lived in Chicago until 1915 when they came to Monticello.

Mrs. Van Houten was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, the Woman's Relief Corps and the Royal Neighbors Lodge in Monticello.

Survivors include her husband; two sons, Harry Van Houten, Monticello, and Lloyd Van Houten, Orangeville; four half brothers, Sam Veenje, Gardena, Calif.; Paul, Monticello, and two half brothers in the Netherlands: one half sister in the Netherlands and three grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by one grandchild, Mary Lynn Van Houten, in 1948.

Services will be Saturday at 3 p.m. in the Zwingli church, Rev. J. C. Oliphant, pastor, officiating. Burial will be in Highland cemetery. Friends may call at the Voegeli funeral home after noon tomorrow.
