Mrs. Van Norman Dies in Milwaukee
Washington Twp. Native Expires Monday; Rites Wednesday

Mrs. E. W. Van Norman, native of Washington township and former resident of Monticello, passed away in Milwaukee at 3:30 a. m. Monday following a period of failing health.

Mrs. Van Norman was about 70 years of age.

Funeral services were held at the Feerick funeral home, Milwaukee yesterday (Wednesday) afternoon.

Mary Barney was born in Washington township, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Milo Barney. She attended school in Monticello and the Monroe high school. She was united in marriage to E. W. Van Norman and they made their home in Monticello for quite a number of years. Mr. Van Norman operated a drug store here and disposed of the business to R. W. Woelffer in 1915. Shortly thereafter, they moved to Oshkosh, where Mr. Van Norman again entered the drug store business. Later they moved to Milwaukee, where the gentleman operated a theater for many years.

Mrs. Van Norman is survived by her husband, two nieces and one nephew.
