Paul H. Veenje, Age 79, Succumbs After Illness; Rites Today

Paul H. Veenje, 79, Monticello resident for many years, died at 3:40 am, Tuesday at the Pleasant View Nursing Home, Monroe, after a long illness.

Mr. Veenje had submitted to surgery in February and was moved to Pleasant View in April.

He was born in Holland, Oct. 11, 1892. He came to America and to Monticello when he was 19 years of age. He farmed in Green county and later was employed by the Green County Highway Dept. for many years.

On July 3, 1942, he was united in marriage to Frieda Wittwer by the Rev. A. R. Achtemeier. That same year he began working for the Karlen & Steinmann Lumber Co., a position he held until retiring in 1957.

He is survived by five daughters, Mrs. Henry Carlson and Mrs. Helen Ellingsrud, Edgerton, Mrs. Ann Moeykens and Mrs. George Capadona, Madison, and Mrs. Robert Blancher, Milwaukee; one step-son, W. H. Wittwer, Madison; two step-daughters, Mrs. Albert Crouch, Monticello, and Mrs. Arlene Meier, Madison; 10 grandchildren, and 11 great-grandchildren.

His wife passed away April 7, 1971. He was also preceded in death by one sister, Mrs. John Van Houten, Monticello, and by a step-son, Clarence Wittwer, in 1967.

Funeral services' will be held at 1:30 p.m. today (Thursday) in the Zwingli United Church of Christ here, of which he was a member. Interment will be in the Swiss church cemetery, New Glarus.
