

Ida Voegeli
August 9, 1890 - January 23, 1983

Ida Voegeli, 92, Monticello, a resident of the New Glarus Home since December 10, 1982, died at the Home Sunday, January 23, 1983 after a lingering illness.

She was born in Green County on August 9, 1890, the daughter of Jacob and Kathryn Hoesly Grunder. She attended rural schools. On December 21, 1911, she married Thomas Voegeli, in Monticello with the late Rev. Albert Muehlmeier officiating. They farmed in Exeter Township until retiring to Monticello in 1944, He died March 27, 1957.

Surviving are a daughter, Mrs. Elwood (Lorna) Schwers, Rice Lake, brother, Ivan Grunder, Monroe; eight grandchildren, 22 great-grandchildren and three great-great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, a daughter, Florence Krajeck, in 1971; a son, Walter T., 1974, and five brothers, Jacob, Henry, Edwin, William and Herman.

Mrs. Voegeli was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, and its Ladies Aid, the John Ross Woman's Relief Corps, a Charter member of G.U.G.G. Lodge of New Glarus, and the Wallace Homemakers Club.

Funeral rites will be held at 11 a.m. Thursday, January 27 in Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, the Rev. Charles G. Workman officiating. Burial will be in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
