Rites Held Monday For John Voegeli

Funeral services for John Voegeli, 81 years of age, Mt. Calvary, near Fond du Lac, who died at 5 p. m. Friday at the home of a daughter, Mrs. Ed. Koenen, of a heart attack, were held at 2 p. m. Monday at the Voegeli funeral home here.

The Rev. A. R. Achtemeier, pastor of the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church, officiated, and burial was in Highland cemetery.

Pallbearers were John Altman, Edmund Dooley, Abraham Kubly, Emory Silver, Ray T. Silver, Sr., and Wm. A. Voegeli.

Mr. Voegeli had been ill for a year following a stroke.

A native of New Glarus, Mr. Voegeli farmed in Green county for many years before moving to Fond du Lac. He was born Jan. 6, 1873. On March 3, 1904, he was united in marriage at Monroe to Elizabeth Prisk. Mr. Voegeli had lived near Fond du Lac since 1942,

Surviving are his wife, Monticello; one son, Marvin J., Monticello; three daughters, Mrs. Koenen, Mrs. Ed. Zierge and Mrs. Herbert Blordorn, Fond du Lac; one sister, Mrs. Peter Ott, New Glarus; and one half-brother, Isaac Babler, Monroe.
