

**Voegeli, Leon A.**  
**July 14, 1895, - July 11, 1989**

MONTICELLO – Leon A. Voegeli, age 93, passed away at the New Glarus Home on Tuesday, July 11, 1989, where he had resided for the last six years.

He was born on July 14, 1895, in Green County, Wisconsin, the son of Baltz and Rose (Figi) Voegeli. He married Emma O. Zimmerman in Monticello on September 22, 1921.

He was a veteran automobile dealer and started his first agency in Monticello in 1914. Then he served in France with the U.S. Army during WWI. He had been a franchised Chevrolet dealer since 1924, and a franchised Buick dealer since 1935; and was recently recognized by the Chevrolet Division of General Motors as the third oldest dealer.

He is survived by a daughter, Mrs. John (Beatrice) Stenbrotten of Monticello; a brother, Emil G. Voegeli of New Glarus; and four grandchildren, John A. (Sally) Stenbrotten of Monticello, Jim Stenbrotten of Madison, Steven L. Stenbrotten, Daniel C. (Mary) Stenbrotten, both of Monticello; two great-grandchildren; and two step-great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his wife; his parents; three brothers; a sister; and a granddaughter.

He was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ, the New Glarus Masonic Lodge #310, and the Amstutz-Marty Post #256 American Legion Monticello.

Services will be on Thursday, July 13, at 10:30 a.m. at the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Pastor Erwin H. Pegel will officiate. Interment will be in Highland Cemetery.

Visitation for Mr. Voegeli will be on Wednesday, after 6:00 in the Zwingli Church Memorial Lounge, 426 E. Lake Ave., Monticello. Out of respect, Voegeli Chevrolet Buick will be closed on Thursday morning until 1:00 p.m.
