Funeral services for Mrs. Henry Voegeli, 85 years of age, highly esteemed and respected resident of the Monticello community for many years, who passed away at her home here Sunday afternoon, were held at 2 Wednesday afternoon in the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church here.

Mrs. Voegeli had been in failing health for some time but her condition became critical last week.

She attended school in her native country and came to America in 1883, coming directly to Monticello. She was united in marriage to Henry Voegeli in 1888, the ceremony taking place in New Glarus. They lived on the Voegeli homestead farm, one mile north of Monticello. Mrs. Voegeli moved to Monticello to make her home in 1945.

Mrs Voegeli was a member of the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church here.

Mrs. Voegeli, through her understanding and pleasant personality, acquired the respect and lasting friendship of a great number of friends, and they received word of her death with deep and sincere regret.

She is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Baltz Hoesly, Monticello; two sons, Joe, Mentor, Minn., and Fred H., Monticello; eight grandchildren, and 11 great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her husband in 1927, and three brothers, Gabriel, New Glarus, Fred, Waterville, N. Y., and Joe, Shawnee, Okla.
