

**Robert Harrison Voegeli**  
**April 25, 1948 – January 22, 1954**  
**Rites Held Sunday For Robert Voegeli**

Robert Harrison Voegeli, five-year-old son of Prof. and Mrs. Donald Voegeli, Madison, died Friday afternoon in a Madison hospital after undergoing surgery Tuesday.

The boy's father, a native of Monticello and graduate of the Monticello high school, is assistant professor of radio education and musical director of station WHA at the University of Wisconsin.

Besides his parents, Robert is survived by a brother, Thomas, 4, and a sister, Kim, 2; his paternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Joe J. Voegeli, Monticello, and his maternal grandmother, Mrs. Blanche Lapple, Madison.
