

Larry LaVern Wahl
March 16, 1958 - March 13, 1977

The funeral for Larry LaVern Wahl, 18, Rt. 2, Monticello, who died early Sunday morning of injuries suffered in a one-car accident, was held today (Wednesday), March 16, at 1:30 p.m. in the Washington Reformation Church, where he was a member. Rev. Duane McDonough officiated and interment was in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.

The son of LaVern G. and Betty M. Voegeli Wahl, he was born on March 16, 1958, in Monroe. He graduated from Argyle High School in 1976, and had been residing at home with his parents, assisting with the farm work, and working part-time at the Midwest Livestock Producers, Monticello.

He is survived by his parents; one brother, Gerald, 11, at home; his paternal grandmother, Mrs. Guy Wahl, Blanchardville; and his maternal grandfather and step-grandmother, Mr. and Mrs. Herman E. Voegeli, Monticello.

While in high school he was a member of the Argyle football team and the FFA. He was confirmed in Washington Reformation Church in 1972.
