Mrs. Webster, Albany, Stricken

Mrs. Mabel Webster, 87, Albany, died at 7 last evening in White Haven Nursing Home, Old Argyle Road, after a long illness from old age complications.

The former Mabel Ione Silver was born in Mt. Pleasant Township March 3, 1880, a daughter of Truman O. and Helen Strunk Silver. She was 22 years old when she married Wilber Webster, a native of Montfort. Mr. Webster was killed by a train in Evansville 25 years ago.

Mrs. Webster had lived in Albany a number of years. Failing health caused her to live in nursing homes.

She was a member of the Albany Chapter, Order of Eastern Star.

Surviving are two brothers, Ray T. and Emory Silver, both of Monticello, and a sister, Mrs. Ben (Mary) Bly, Evansville. Her father died Nov. 30, 1944 and her mother, Jan. 20, 1945.

Services were at 2:30 p.m. Sunday in the Sharer Funeral Home at Albany. Rev. Burton Artz of the Albany Methodist Church officiated. Burial was in Exeter Cemetery.
