FUNERAL SERVICE FOR MRS. WHIPPLE
Evansville Woman Whose Death Occurred Sunday
Laid at Rest at Attica Cemetery

[Janesville Daily Gazette] - Evansville, Tuesday, Nov. 12. -- Mrs. Amelia Whipple was born August 10, 1853, and passed away Sunday evening, between four and five o'clock. Although she has been in poor health for some time the end came unexpectedly, death being attributed to heart trouble.

She was the oldest of three children and was born in Attica, where her father Joshua Clark was a wood workman and a wagon maker for many years.

She was united in marriage to George Whipple to which the union bore seven children, five of whom survive here are Claude, Eder and daughter Orpha of Evansville; Mrs. Frank Borden of Beloit and Mrs. Bert Edwards of Exeter. Also two sisters, Mrs. E. W. Scott of Belleville and Mrs. Charles Ross of this city along with her husband mourn the loss of a devoted sister and wife.

For the past twenty years Mr. and Mrs. Whipple have lived near Evansville, where she has made a large circle of friends to sympathize and morn with the relatives in their bereavement. Funeral services were conducted at the house today at 10:00 o'clock and later at the Attica church, interment being in Attica.
