Funeral services were held Saturday, Nov. 29, in the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, for Herman Wittenwyler, 67, Monticello, who died Tuesday, Nov. 25, unexpectedly from an apparent heart attack at the Pleasant View Nursing Home. Rev. Charles Workman officiated and internment was in Highland Cemetery.

He was born on the Wittenwyler farm in Washington township on October 6, 1908. He was the son of John and Anna Feldman Wittenwyler. He attended Simmons rural school and assisted his father with farm work until the family moved to the village in 1944. He entered the Monroe Manor in 1970 and had been in Pleasant View since May 1 of 1975.

Survivors include aunts, uncles, and cousins. He was preceded in death by his parents, his father in 1972 and his mother in 1958.

He was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ.
