Wilbert H. "Burl" Wittwer, 78, Madison, died Tuesday, Aug. 11, 1992 at Meriter Park Hospital.

He was born Feb. 11, 1914 in rural Monticello, the son of Albert and Frieda (Spring) Wittwer.
