Louis Wyss, 73, Mesa, Ariz., died Mar. 8, 1989 at the Cosada Villa, Mesa.

The son of Alois and Sophie Bonnetti Wyss was born Mar. 13, 1915 at Fennimore, Wis. On Sept. 8, 1945 he was united in marriage to the former Kathleen Joan Kingston in Australia. Louis owned and operated a hotel in Monticello for many years until 1982 when he moved to Mesa.

He was a former member of the Monticello Fire Dept., the Monticello Village Board and a life member of VFW Post 2312-Monroe. He was a veteran of WW II, having served in the Asian-Pacific Theater.
