March 25, 1866 - 1921

Mrs. Jacob F. Marty, 55 years old died very suddenly Saturday at her home at Monroe. Her death resulted from heart trouble.

Her husband, who is a foreman at the county farm, returned home Saturday evening about 6:45. and found his wife lying dead on the kitchen floor.

Death undoubtedly occurred near 6 o'clock, as all preparations had been made for the cooking of the evening meal. The food was ready for the fire and a burner of the gas stove had been turned on. It is surmised that just as she had turned on the gas and was about to Strike a match to ignite it beneath the coffee pot, she was stricken with a heart attack, fell and died.

Mrs. Marty was born March 25, 1866, in New Glarus township. She was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Andrew Legler. On January 29, 1888, she married Fridolin Zentner at Monticello. Mr. Zentner died Sept. 6, 1914, and she moved to Monroe and in 1919 married Mr. Marty.

The deceased is survived by her husband, and three children. Two brothers, George Legler of Adams township and David Legler of New Glarus, and one sister, Mrs. Anton Portman, Monroe, also survive.

Funeral services were held at the German Reformed church of Monticello Tuesday. The Rev. Muehlmeier officiated and burial took place at Highland cemetery.
