

**Henry Zentner**  
**July 3, 1886 - April 21, 1965**  
**Henry Zentner Stricken at 78**

Henry Zentner, 78, of 2309 13th Ave., a retired carpenter, died at 4:20 p.m. yesterday in a Green County hospital after several weeks failing health.

He was born on the Zentner homestead farm in Washington Township July 3, 1886, the son of Hilarius and Margaretha Zentner Zentner. He attended Voegeli rural school. On Jan. 9, 1908 he was married in Monticello to Kathryn Voegeli. They farmed a few years in Washington Township and then moved to Monticello. Mrs. Zentner died Jan. 20, 1939.

On July 1, 1947, Mr. Zentner was married in Iowa to Viola Leopold of Monroe. Since then he had resided in Monroe. He retired from carpentry in 1952.

Surviving are his wife, a son, Mathias, Monticello; a daughter, Violet Zentner, at home; two brothers, Casper, Monticello, and Emil, Nekoosa; two sisters, Mrs. Herman Klassy and Mrs. Barbara Jordan, both of Monticello; one grandchild and three great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents; a sister, Mrs. Jacob Duerst, New Glarus, and two brothers, Fred, northern Wisconsin, and Oswald, Monticello, Oct. 8, 1962.

Services will be held at 11 a.m. Saturday in the Voegeli Funeral Home, Monticello. Rev. J. Allan Mittler of Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, will officiate. Burial will be there in Highland Cemetery.
