

**Matt H. Zentner**  
**Sept. 30, 1908 - March 11, 1974**

Funeral services for Matt H. Zentner, 65, Monticello, who died at 8 a.m. Monday, March 11, in Pleasant View Nursing Home, will be at 3 p.m. Thursday, March 14, in Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, where he was a member. His pastor, Rev. Charles G. Workman, is to officiate. Burial will be there in Highland Cemetery.

Mr. Zentner, a former Monticello businessman, had been in failing health for some time. He was hospitalized on Jan. 13 and then transferred to the nursing home on Feb. 13.

He was born in Washington Township Sept. 30, 1908, a son of Henry and Kathryn Voegeli Zentner, and attended Monticello schools. On Nov. 4, 1930, he was married to Ruth Youngreen. In the past, Mr. Zentner had owned and operated a service station and also a tavern.

Surviving are his widow, Ruth, an elementary school teacher at Monticello; a son, Matthew J., Rt. 1, Belleville, and three grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents.
