E. G. Zimmerman, 78, Attica, Dies Saturday Of Heart Condition

Funeral services for Erwin G. Zimmerman, 78 years of age retired farmer and former owner of the Attica store, who died at 9 Saturday night in the Stoughton Community hospital, were held at 2 Tuesday afternoon in the Sharer funeral home, Albany.

The Rev. John Walker, pastor of the Evansville Methodist church, officiated, and burial was in Hillcrest cemetery, Albany.

Mr. Zimmerman had been ill for a number of weeks from a heart condition and had been hospitalized twice at Stoughton. He entered the hospital the last time on Thursday of last week.

He was born Oct. 7, 1882, in Sylvester township, the son of Rudolph and Verena Zimmerman Zimmerman. On Nov. 14, 1907, he was united in marriage to Edna Lewis, the ceremony taking place in Albany. They had lived on the present farm at Attica for the past 46 years Mr. and Mrs. Zimmerman operated the Attica store for 14 years.
