Rites Held Here for Mrs. Zimmerman, 79
Aged Local Lady Expires Thursday at Home of Son

Mrs. Peter Zimmerman, aged 79, resident of Monticello for many years, passed away last Thursday at the home of her son, Ray Zimmerman, Gratiot, after an extended illness.

Funeral services were held in Gratiot Saturday and burial was in Highland cemetery here.

Mrs. Zimmerman had made her home with her son since last June. Mr. Zimmerman expired May 26 of this year.

The former Louise Kafer, she was married to Peter Zimmerman in Monroe Aug. 18, 1890. They resided in Monroe until 1904, when they moved to a farm east of Monticello. Leaving there, they operated a farm near the Monticello Woolen Mills until 1917, when they moved to Monticello. Mr. Zimmerman was street commissioner here until 1938.

Surviving are the son, Ray, and three grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her husband, one daughter, Mrs. George Armstrong, and one son, Glenn.
