Mrs. J. Zimmerman, 88, Monroe, Dies Former Washington Twp. Resident Dies at Home

Funeral services for Mrs. John Zimmerman, 88 years of age, native of Switzerland and a resident of Washington township for many years, were held at 1 Sunday afternoon in Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church.

The Rev. A. R. Achtemeier, church pastor, officiated, and burial was in Highland cemetery.

Mrs. Zimmerman moved to Monroe nine years ago and passed away at the home of her son-in-law and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. Paul L. Frenzel. She had been in poor health for the past 17 weeks.

She was born in Canton Bern, Switzerland, June 30, 1862, the daughter of John and Marie Theiler, prominent Washington township residents, who came to America 66 years ago. On Sept. 23, 1886, she was united in marriage to John Zimmerman. They farmed in Washington township for many years. Mr. Zimmerman passed away in 1938, Mrs. Zimmerman moving to Monroe nine years ago.

Mrs. Zimmerman was a member of the Washington Reformed church and of its Ladies' Aid society.

Surviving are four daughters, Mrs. Frenzel, Mrs. George G. Bleiler, and Mrs. Harold E. Holcomb, Monroe, and Mrs. Jacob M. Marty, New Glarus; three sons, Robert, Washington township, Edward, Beloit, and Wilbert, Monroe township; a sister, Marianna, in Switzerland; 19 grandchildren, and 20 great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by three brothers, four sisters and one grandchild in addition to her husband.
