MONTICELLO OLDEST RESIDENT IS DEAD

MONTICELLO, Wis. -- Thomas Zimmerman, 91, Monticello's oldest resident, died here Friday.

He is survived by his wife: four daughters, Mrs. Henry E. Elmer, and Mrs. Leon Voegeli, both of Monticello; Mrs. Fred Hadinger, Ft. Atkinson; Mrs. Charles Eckberg, Plymouth; one half-sister, Mrs. Catherine Wittwer. New Glarus.

Funeral services will be held Sunday at 2 in the Zwingli Evangelical Reformed church, Monticello, with the Rev. A. Achtemeier officiating. The body will be brought to the church at 12:30 on Sunday.

ADDED: *Thomas Zimmerman -Born November 13, 1850 in Exeter Township, Green County, WI. His family came from Schwanden, Switzerland. Died March 5, 1942 and is buried in Highland Cemetery in Monticello, WI.*

Thomas and Susanna Zimmerman lived on a farm in New Glarus Township when they were first married. Later they bought a farm near Monticello (Lawrence Karlen farm (intersection of State Hwy 69 and County Rd C) where they lived until they retired to Monticello in 1909. They bought a house that Ezer Babler had built the year before for his bride Anna K. Ezer was killed in the Spanish American War and the house was sold to Grandpa & Grandma Zimmerman.
