Gottlieb Zum Brunnen

Gottlieb Zum Brunnen, who emigrated to Green county in 1852, coming from Berne, Switzerland, in company with his parents, died at his home in Washington township on Saturday evening. He was born in 1856(?) and was the last survivor of a large family of children.

Mr. Zum Brunnen was a veteran of the civil war, being a member of the 22nd Wisconsin regiment. He fought under Sherman, participated in the famous march-to the sea, and was in every battle in which his regiment figured during the campaign. He bore the privations and hardships of army life with a fortitude worthy the true soldier. For three months he was among the captured in Libby prison,

After the close of the war he returned to his home in Washington township, and his marriage to Sabina Hefty followed on the 11th of May, 1866. Besides his widow, he is survived by a family of 15 children.

His remains will be cremated in accordance with his wish, they having been taken to Milwaukee for that purpose on Monday.
