Short Illness Fatal To Bernard Zweifel

Former Monticello Sector Citizen Dies Wednesday, Services Held

Funeral services for Bernard Zweifel, 80 years of age, a native of Switzerland, and a former resident of the Monticello community and well known to many in this section, who passed away on Wednesday of last week in the Monroe hospital following a week's illness, were conducted at 2 Friday afternoon at the Newcomer funeral home, Brodhead. Burial was in Greenwood cemetery, Brodhead.

Native of Switzerland

Bernard Zweifel was a native of Switzerland and was born July 27, 1862, the son of Bernard and Fannie Voegeli Zweifel. He came to America when a young man, and settled near Monticello in 1882. He was married Sept. 22, 1904, to Minnie Aebly, daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Melchior Aebly. They resided in the Spring Grove community for many years.

The widow is the only survivor, a son and a daughter having died in infancy.
